Fire Extinguisher Use

Kids Corner

Wear a Mini Fireproof Suit

These are fireproof suits worn by the fire brigade in childrens' sizes. You can try them on and take pictures.



Disaster Drill Ring Toss

This is a game in which you throw a ring onto a peg with a drawing related to disaster prevention. Learn about disaster preparedness while having fun.



Fire Truck Ride

You can sit in the driver's seat of the fire brigade truck.
